PROJECT DESCRIPTION IN MOTHER TONGUE

Kompleks OŠ "Svetozar Marković" sastoji se od tri objekta - škole, fiskulturne sale i bazenu, uz koje su izgrađeni i sportski tereni za košarku, trivale i igraliste za najmlađe. Lokacija škole je u sklopu gradiščke jezgre, u zoni starog parka, nadovezujući se na postojeći borov šumi park koji postaje važan motiv u oblikovanju i arhitekturi. Tri objekta - škola, fiskulturna sala i bazen, se formalno čitaju kao zasebni objekti iako se, spojeni topilm vezama, preklapaju i uranjuju u teren transformišući se u jedinstvenu funkcionalnu celinu. Motiv šume ukazuje na mir, kojem se suprotstavlja dinamičnost saobraćajnica koje okružuju lokaciju. Kao ledeni breg, objekat nastaje kao barijera između ove suprotnosti. Prateći granice parcele, objekat izlaze unutrašnji prostor od spoljnih uticaja, nežno ga obuhvata i štiti, formirajući unutrašnje dvorište koje postaje sklonište, bezbedna zona koju štiti i socijalizuje. U tom smislu, objekat na temu "cover me softly" odgovara kao oklop, onaj koji štiti i obezbeđuje deci skriuenu ozu u svom sredistu. Objekat škole je najdominantniji, zauzima ugaonu poziciju i u direktnoj je interakciji sa okruženjem. Objekat je podelen na kružna namenjena nižim i višim razredima

The "Svetozar Marković" elementary school complex consists of three buildings - a school, a gym, and a swimming pool, along with sports courts for basketball, volleyball, bleachers and a playground for the youngest. The school is located in the city center, in the area of the old park, next to the existing pine forest, which has become an important motif in design. The school, the gym, and the swimming pool are formally real as separate objects, although connected, they overlap and immerse themselves in the terrain, transforming into a unique functional unit. The forest motif indicates peace, opposing the dynamic city traffic surrounding the site. Like an iceberg, the complex is a barrier between these two opposites. Following the site's boundaries, the building isolates the inner yard from external influences, and gently covers and protects it, forming an inner courtyard that becomes a shelter, a safe zone for sports and socialization. Regarding the theme "cover me softly" this building responds like an armor that protects and provides children with a hidden oasis in its center. The school building has the most dominant position and is in direct interaction with the environment. The building is divided into two wings, for lower and upper grades, that join at the very corner, forming a

hall that can transform into a multi-purpose space. This hall with a vertical atrium is directly connected to the inner courtyard. On the first floor, the atrium connects to the library, and on the second floor the reading room. These spaces occupy the most attractive position in the building. There is a noticeable gradation of the openness of the buildings to the external environment - the school building is the most open to the dynamics of the environment, but its form creates an internal, protected environment; the gym opens its street facade but hides its contents with the additional delineation of the sports terrain, and the swimming pool is completely closed to the environment and opens only towards the forest. The materialization of the facade and the roof is the same, so the building leaves a monolithic impression. The monolith of the street facade is interrupted continuously, in clear and long strokes, while the courtyard of the street facade is more dynamic. The entire school complex is fully adapted to people with disabilities, designed for a total of 960 students. The total gross area of the building is 9870 sqm, while the usable, net area is 8960 sqm.
